Are supermarkets designed to persuade us to buy more? When you enter a supermarket, the manager knows better than you do ; how you will behave , which way you will walk, where you will look, what will make you buy something rather than another. The layout of a supermarket is designed to take shoppers around the store ,from left to right. Then, shoppers will pay attention to all the products.

Fresh fruits and vegetables are shown near supermarket **entrance**. This gives the impression that only healthy food is sold in the shop. Basic food that everyone buys, like sugar and tea are not put next to each other. **They** are kept in different places so customers go past other attractive goods before they find them.
