1. The moon (went- go- goes) around the Earth.
2. The sun (rose- rise- rises) in the east.
3. How long (doing- does- do) the Earth take to go around the sun?
4. The planets (goes- going- go) around the sun.
5. Kuwait (consists- consist- consisting) largely of a flat desert.
6. Kuwait (didn't- don't- doesn't) have rivers.
7. Fish (lived- lives- live) in water.
8. Where (do- does- did) the planets go around?

**Present Simple expresses habitual actions: (حدث هو عادات متكررة)**

**always - usually - sometimes - often - every - never - rarely**

1. My grandmother **always** (goes- went- go) to the park on Fridays.
2. We (drinking- drank- drink) milk **every** morning.
3. Sara (don't- doesn't- didn't) like eggs.
4. Ali **never** (plays- played- play) in the street.
5. **Sometimes**, Ali and Sara (goes- go- went) to the library.
