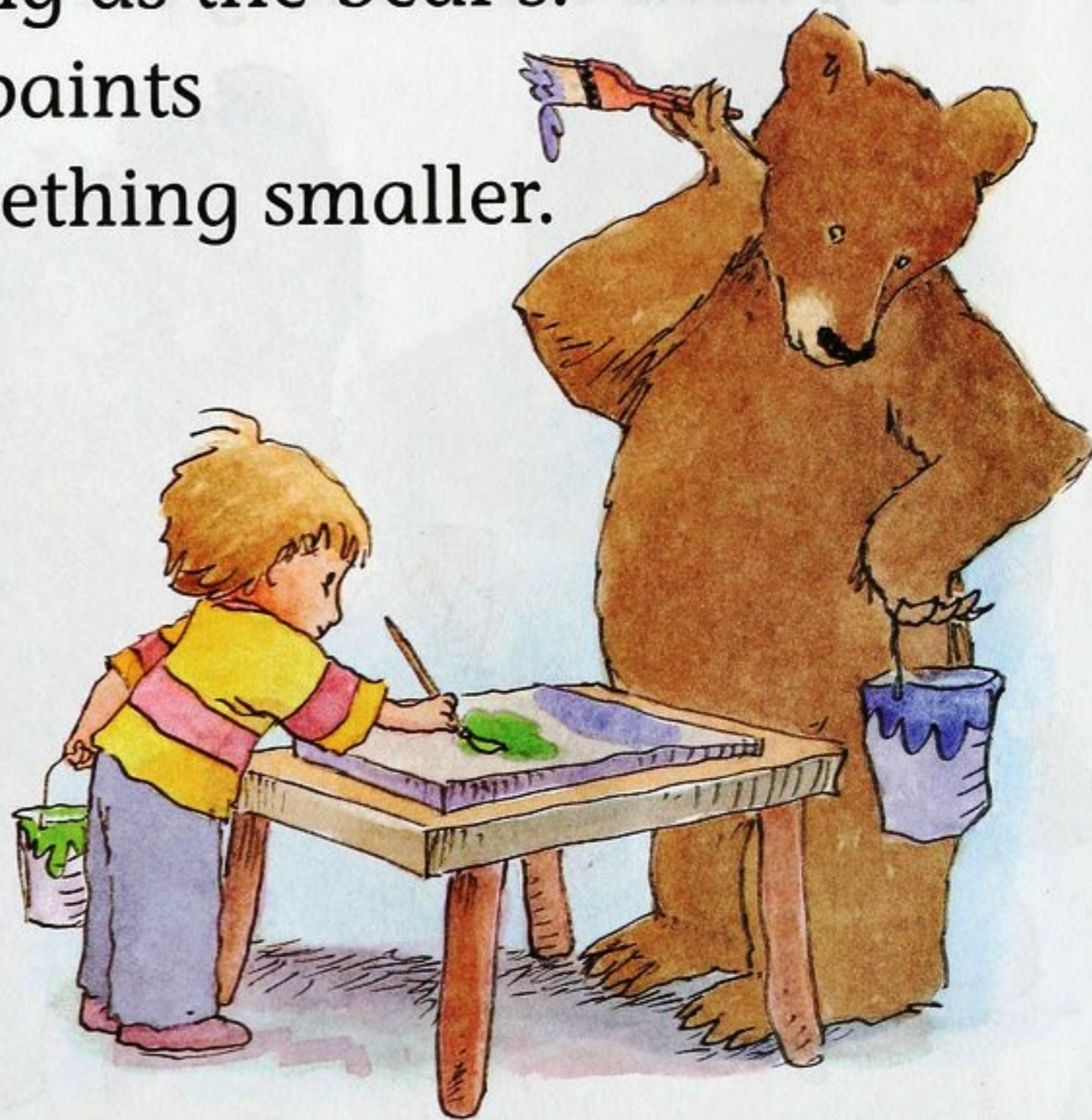
The bug, the boy, and the bear

something smaller.



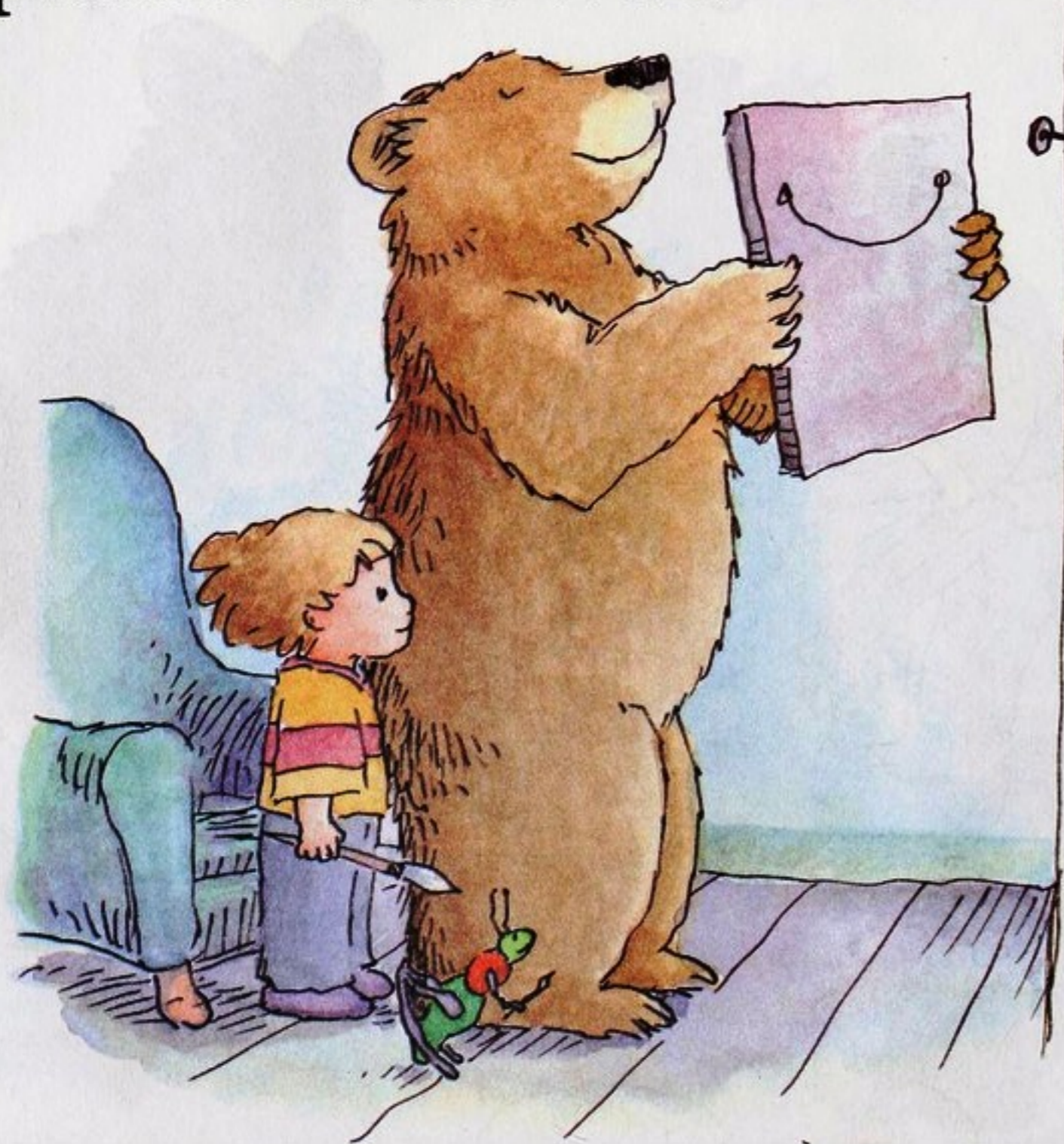
The bug has a tiny brush.
He paints something smaller.



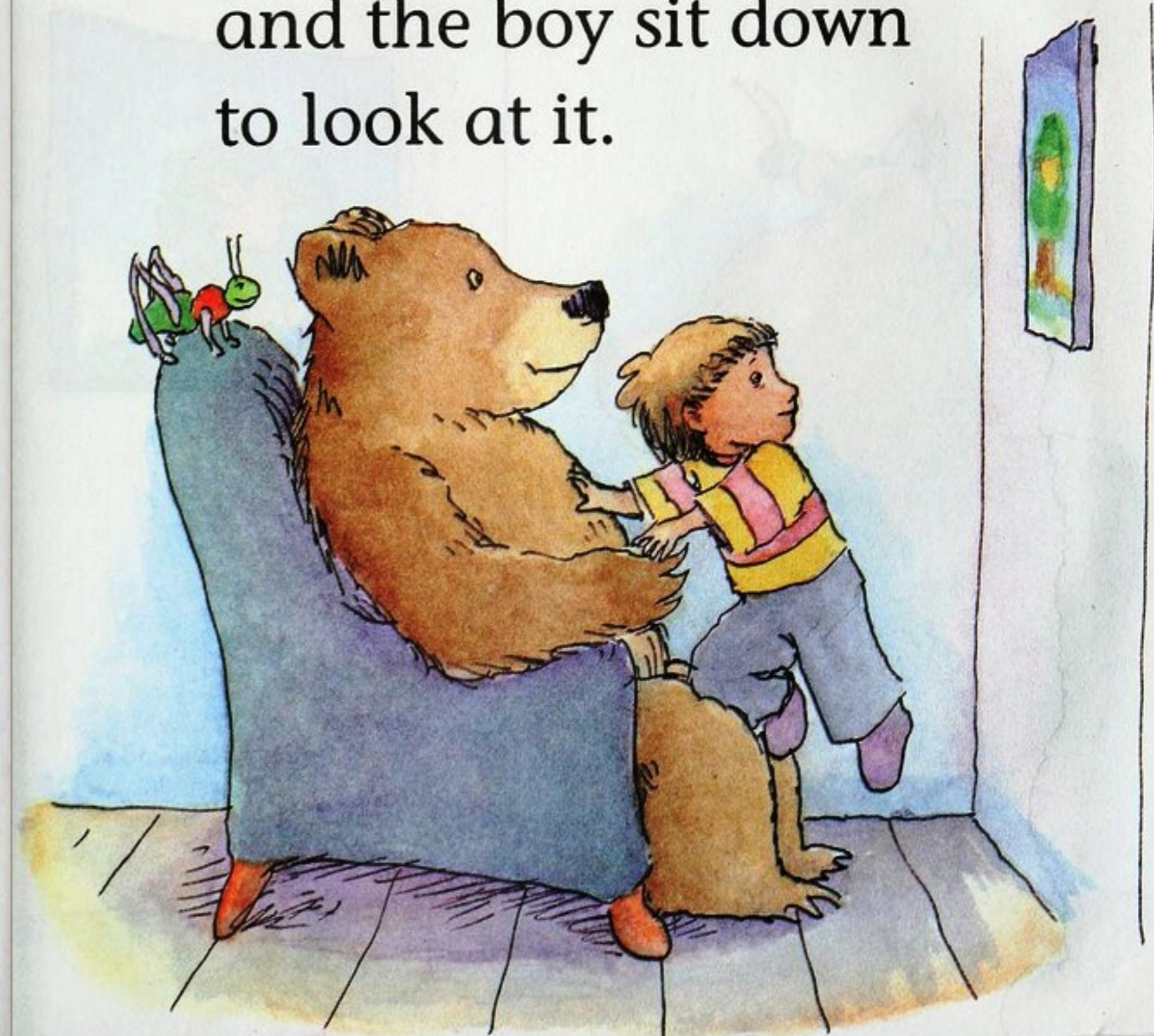
They paint for a long time.



The bear hangs the picture on the wall.



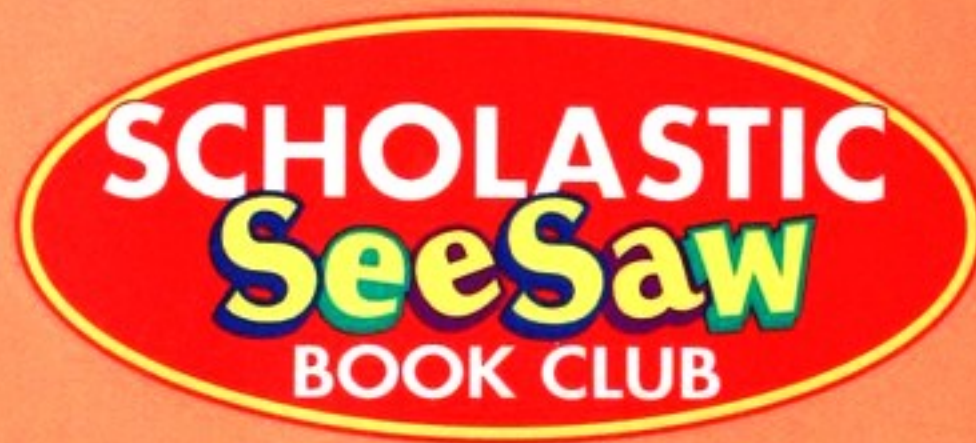
Then the bug, the bear, and the boy sit down to look at it.
