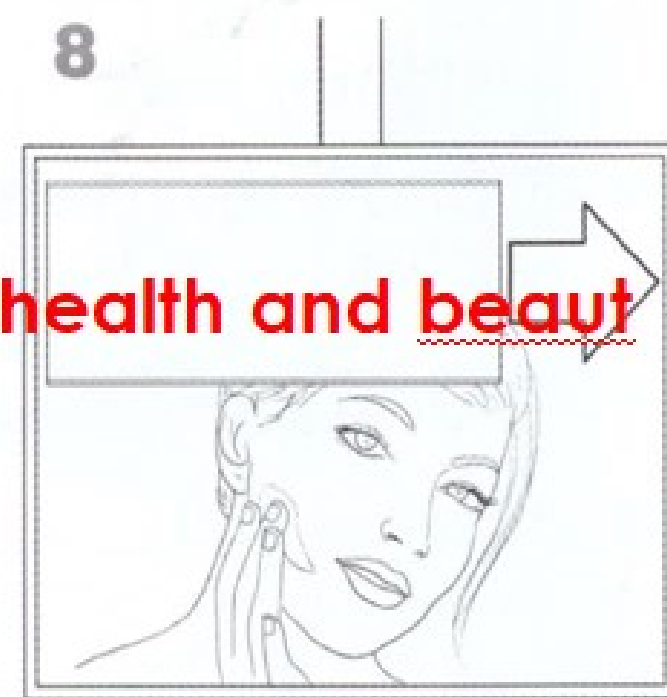
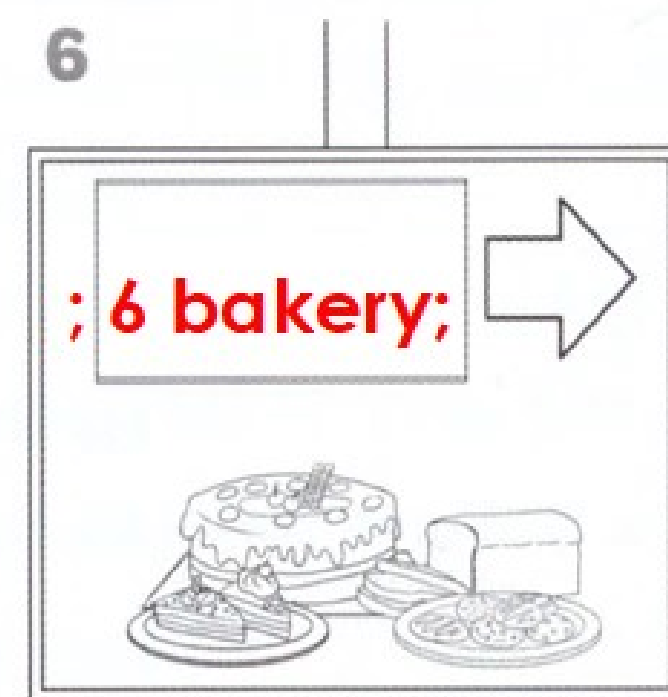
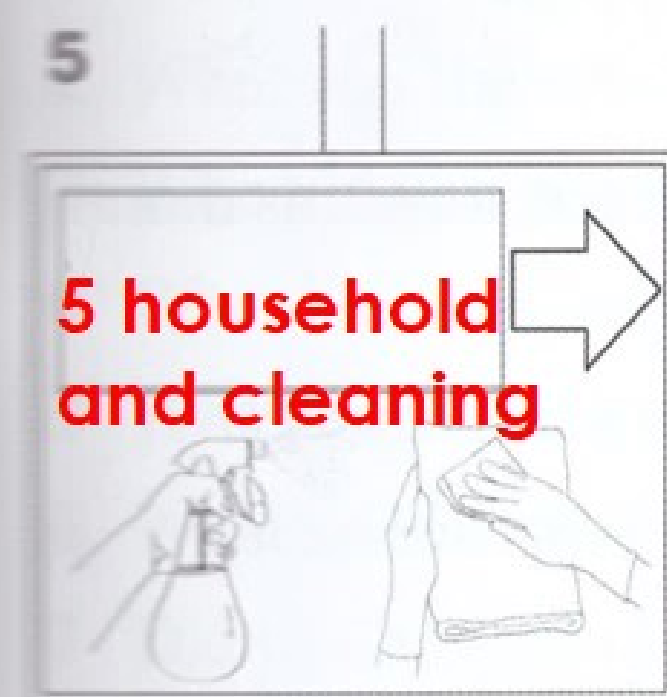
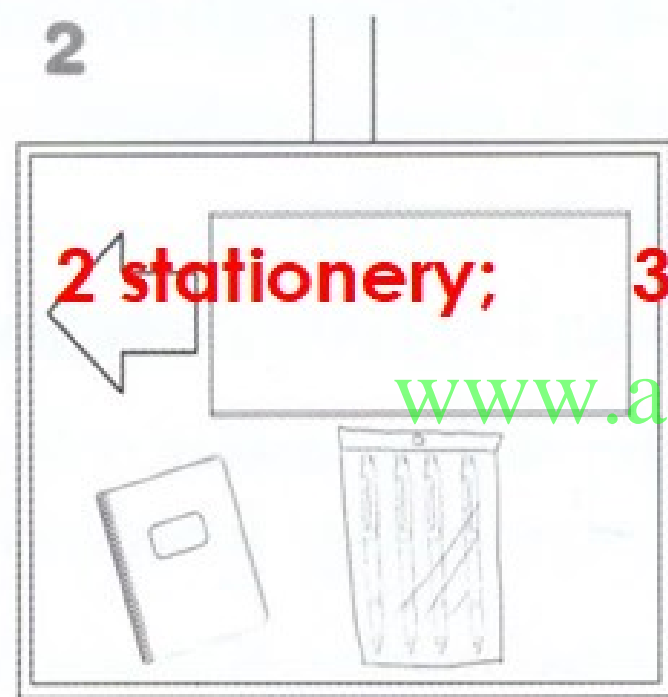
Did you know?

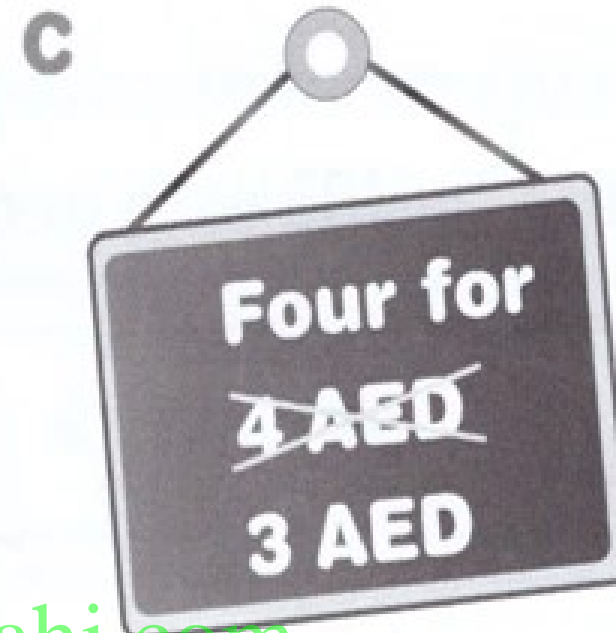

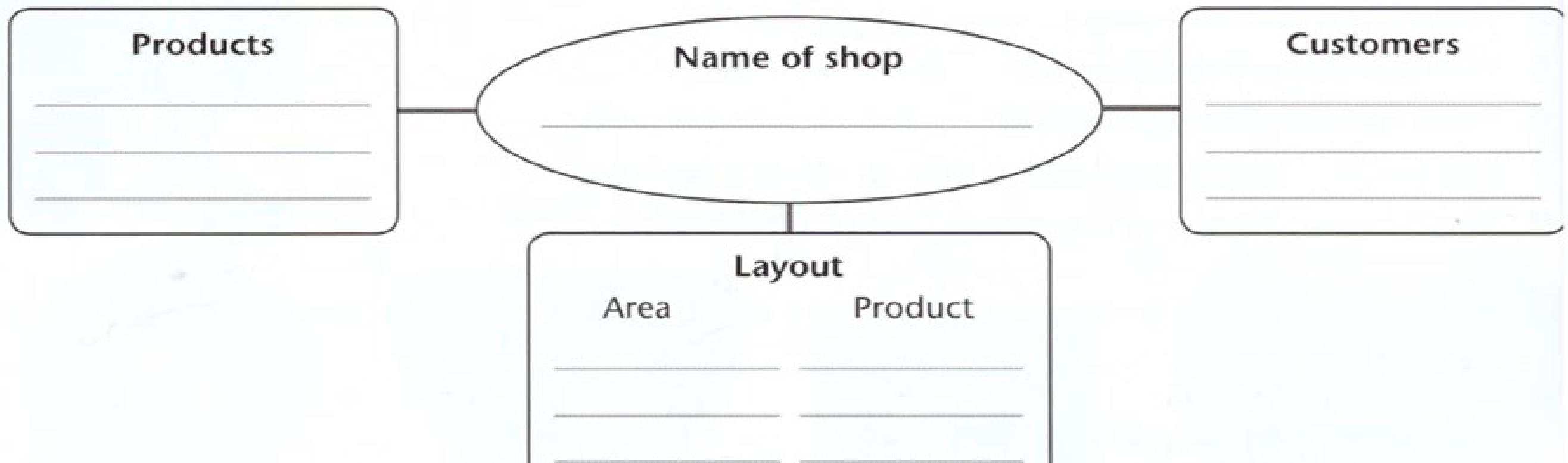
